MES FOUNDATION PROVIDES \$200,000 TO MAINE STUDENTS

Alfred, Maine - June 15, 2020 – MES Foundation (MES) announced today the winners of the Richard H. Pierce Memorial Scholarship, which totaled \$200,000 in awards to 10 Maine students. Established in honor of MES founder, Dick Pierce, who passed away in 2011, this \$5,000 renewable scholarship is awarded based on distinguished academic merit and financial need.

"I am completely blown away that I was selected to receive this extremely competitive scholarship," said scholarship winner Rachael Sickles. Rachael is a graduate from Dexter Regional High School and will be attending UMaine Orono in the fall. "Thanks to MES, I am now able to confidently pursue a degree in animal sciences and pursue my passion for dairy farm work."

Four years ago, MES significantly expanded scholarship offerings and to date has awarded \$887,000 to Maine students.

"We hope to lessen the financial stress placed on our Maine students and their families, while they pursue a post-secondary education," said MES Foundation Executive Director Kristie Hurlburt. "We are thrilled to invest in the future of these exemplary students as they enter the next chapter of their lives."
